Johan Heinrich Daniel, son of Adam and Christina Barbara (Kleist) Daniel, was born 11 Jul 1754 in Bethel Twp., Berks Co PA; was baptized 4 Aug 1754 at Zion's Blue Mountain Church, Strausstown, Berks Co PA; and died 7 Nov 1841 in Jackson Twp., Northumberland Co PA; bur. Saint Peter's (Krebs) Church Cemetery, Red Cross, Northumberland Co PA. He was married 14 Dec 1779 Stouchsburg Lutheran Church, Marion Twp., Berks Co PA to Maria Magdalena Miller/Mueller, daughter of Jacob Miller, born ca. 1758, and died 25 Feb (elsewhere Mar) 1823 Northumberland Co PA. Henry Daniel of Jackson Twp., Northumberland Co PA made his will on 21 Jun 1838 and letters of administration were issued on 20 Nov 1841 [Northumberland Co Wills, v. 3, p. 390-1]. Eight heirs are named in the will in the order given below. No wife is named. There is no stone entry (at least online) for the wife, although she is listed in *A Genealogist's Guide to Burials in Northumberland County, Pennsylvania*, Vol. III, p. 166, by Joseph A. and Sarah (Roadarmel) Meiser (1985). The *Genealogical and Biographical Annals of Northumberland County, Pennsylvania*, by J.L. Floyd & Co., 1911, p. 275, says: "Heinrich Daniel, great-grandfather of John Daniel, was born July 6, 1755, in Bethel township, Berks Co., Pa., and coming to Washington (then Jackson) township, Northumberland county, located on a tract of 110 acres upon which he erected the original set of buildings. A log house he built in the year 1800 is still standing. On this place Heinrich Daniel lived from 1774 until his death, which occurred Nov. 7, 1841. His wife, Maria Magd., died in 1823, aged sixty-five years. Their home stood near the mountain. They had a number of children, among whom were Heinrich and John Adam, the latter succeeding to the ownership of the farm."

2. Andreas Daniel, b. 4 Aug 1781 Bethel Twp., Berks Co PA; bap. 31 Aug 1781 Altalaha Evangelical Lutheran Church, Rehrersburg, Berks Co PA; sponsor, Andreas Daniel; assume died young because of the Andrew Daniel born in 1797 who is mentioned in the father's will.

Saint Pauls Cemetery, Glenford, Perry Co OH; married Elizabeth Emrich, b. 28 Jun 1797 Rebuck, Northumberland Co PA; d. 1841 Perry Co OH (stone in pieces); bur. Saint Pauls Cemetery, Glenford, Perry Co OH; elsewhere called Elizabeth Parry [no source provided, maybe they are getting the Parry from the Perry County residence].
4. Maria/Mary Margret Daniel, b. 2 Feb 1784 Bethel Twp., Berks Co PA; d. 10 Sep 1861 Northumberland Co PA; bur. Stone Valley Cemetery, Hickory Corners, Northumberland Co PA; m. ca. 1801 to John/Johannes Barman (Bowman/Baumann), b. 9 Mar 1780 Jordan Twp., Northumberland Co PA; d. 8 Jun 1859 Lower Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA; bur. Stone Valley Cemetery, Hickory Corners, Northumberland Co PA. Marget and John Bowman acknowledge receipt of \$100 as an heir of Henry Daniel of Jackson Twp., Northumberland Co PA, from Adam Daniel, executor, on 29 Oct 1847 [Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. FF, p. 369-70].
5. Johannes Georg Daniel, b. 13 Jul 1787 Northumberland Co PA, bap. 6 Aug 1787 in Rebuck Evangelical Lutheran & Reformed Church, Northumberland Co PA, sponsors, Frederick

Kobel and wife Magdalena Sophia; FamilySearch Tree has Himmel Lutheran & Reformed Church, Washington Twp., Northumberland Co PA; died Jul 1860; bur. Zion Reformed & Lutheran Cemetery, Thornville, Perry Co OH; married Saloma Seitz, b. ca. 1789 Northampton Co PA; died 1855 Perry Co OH.

6. Johannes Heinrich Daniel, b. 3 Jan 1790 Northumberland Co PA; baptized 1 May 1791 Rebeck Evangelical Lutheran Church, Northumberland Co PA, sponsors, Rauschkolb and wife Marian; died possibly Feb 1823 Upper Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA (and definitely by 1838); wife likely Catharine Kauffman (see below).
7. Magdalena Daniel, b. ca. 1792 Northumberland Co PA; m. 5 Feb 1814 Upper Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA (*Northumberland Republicaner*) to Isaac Stewart/Stuart, b. ca. 1790. 1820 Census, Augusta Twp., Northumberland Co PA – cannot locate after this.
8. Johannes Adam Daniel, b. 8 Jun 1795 Northumberland Co PA; d. 1 Jun 1878 Northumberland Co PA; bur. St. Peter's Lutheran Church Cemetery, Red Cross, Northumberland Co PA; married first 10 Apr 1814 Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA (*Northumberland Republicaner*) to Eva Rosanna Wagner, b. 11 Oct 1790 Little Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA; d. 15 Jul 1847 Northumberland Co PA; married second to Mary Magdalena (Carl) Rubendahl, b. 5 Apr 1798 Northumberland Co PA; d. 29 Sep 1849 Northumberland Co PA; married third to Esther Hettie Frymoyer, b. 22 Feb 1804 Northumberland Co PA; d. 30 Mar 1881 Northumberland Co PA. Three wives all buried in St. Peter's Lutheran Church Cemetery, Red Cross, Northumberland Co PA.
9. Andreas/Andrew Daniel, b. 14 Sep 1797 Northumberland Co PA; d. 12 Oct 1880 Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA; bur. Trinity UCC Cemetery, Rehrersburg, Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA; m. 29 Nov 1818 Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA to Catherine Reber, b. 11 Feb 1800 Upper Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA; d. 3 Apr 1893 Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA; bur. Trinity UCC Cemetery, Rehrersburg, Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA. Andrew Daniel of Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co PA, acknowledged the receipt of \$100 from John Adam Daniel, executor, as an heir of Henry Daniel, on 13 Nov 1848, no wife named [Northumberland Co Deeds, v. GG, p. 368-9].

Johannes Heinrich Daniel, Jr., son of Heinrich and Maria Magdalena (Miller) Daniel, was born 3 Jan 1790 in Northumberland Co PA. He was deceased when his father made his will 21 Jun 1838, and proved 29 Mar 1843, when the six heirs of Henry Daniel, Jr., began acknowledging payments from Adam Daniel, executor of the grandfather Henry Daniel, late of Jackson Twp. (died 1841). The younger Henry is generally identified as being a resident of Upper Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA at the time of his death, Jackson Township being created later – the family farm didn't move. His wife is not named at this point. The will for the elder Henry says "to my son John Henry Daniel to his heirs," and "one Hundred dollars to the heirs of my son John Henry Daniel six years after my decease." Henry Daniel, Jr., likely died as early as Feb 1823 when letters of administration were granted as follows: "That on the tenth day of February A.D. 1823, letters of administration, in due and common form of law, were granted to Isaac Stewart of all and singular, the goods and chattels, rights and credits, which were of Henry Daniel, late of Upper Mahanoy Township, deceased, who have put in sureties, Adam Daniel, the sum of five hundred dollars" [Northumberland Co Wills, v. 2, p. 430]. Elisabeth Daniel, one of the six heirs, is believed to be an unmarried daughter rather than the widow, but this could be the wrong assumption.

Northumberland Co PA Wills, v. 3, p. 82-83, in the will for Leonard Kauffman of Upper Mahanoy Township, made 30 Oct 1830 and proved 27 Feb 1831, identifies children, including “Catharine, wife to Henry Daniel”. Johann Leonhardt Kauffman was born 17 Feb 1760 in Brickerville, Lancaster Co PA; and died 14 Jan 1831 in Upper Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA. His wife, Elizabeth Kobel, was born 30 Jun 1762 in Bethel Twp., Berks Co PA; and died 28 Oct 1850 in Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA. This Catharine (Kauffman) Daniel is believed to be the 30-39 year old female in the 1830 Upper Mahanoy Township census and therefore the widow of Henry Daniel, Jr., although the husband (who died in 1823) isn’t identified as deceased in Kauffman’s 1830 will. No mention of minors is made in Northumberland County Orphan’s Court minutes for this time period, so this would make sense that the mother, likely Catharine Kauffman, was still living and had the means necessary to raise her children with guardianships not being necessary. The writer has not visited the courthouse or research facilities in Northumberland County to learn if the will and administration packets still exist (File 78 for Henry Daniel Jr. and File 125 for Henry Daniel Sr. and File 89 for Leonard Kauffman). Distributions and receipts in those folders should verify that the Henry Daniel who died in 1823 is indeed ours and that his widow was this Catharine Daniel in the 1830 census. *A Genealogy and History of the Kauffman-Coffman Families of North America, 1584 to 1937*, p. 704, suggests the same, with the information coming no doubt from the Leonard Kauffman will, but this genealogy is lacking correct information on the six children, although they were aware of the writer’s ancestor, Catharine (Daniel) Fetterman of Sandusky Co OH. The mother, Catherine (Kauffman) Daniel, was born 10 Oct 1793 in Upper Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA; and died 14 Apr 1842 in Dauphin Co PA according to several Ancestry.com trees, but I cannot locate a source for that date/place. The FamilySearch tree has Catharina Kauffman Daniel dying in 1843 in Franklin Grove, Lee Co IL, but again, no reference is provided.

FF, p. 337].
2. Elidia [Lydia] Daniel, b. 29 Jan 1813 Northumberland Co PA; d. 27 Mar 1892 Northumberland Co PA; bur. Saint Johns Cemetery, Leck Kill, Northumberland Co PA; married George Brown/Braun, b. 26 Apr 1809; d. 13 Jul 1864 Northumberland Co PA; bur. Saint Johns Cemetery, Leck Kill, Northumberland Co PA. Elidia Brown, Judit Rotharmel, Susana Snyder, and Elisabeth Daniel jointly released their rights to Adam Daniel and John

Barman as heirs of Henry Daniel of Jackson Twp., Northumberland Co PA on 30 Nov 1846 [their grandfather] [Northumberland Co Deeds, v. FF, p. 336-7].

3. Elisabeth Daniel, b. ca. 1815 Northumberland Co PA; still single in 1846. No information as to death or possible spouse.
4. Susana Daniel, b. 26 Jun 1818 Northumberland Co PA; d. 13 Nov 1898 Northumberland Co PA; bur. Saint Johns Cemetery, Leck Kill, Northumberland Co PA; married Abraham Snyder, b. 5 Mar 1818 Northumberland Co PA; d. 18 Apr 1894 Northumberland Co PA; bur. Saint Johns Cemetery, Leck Kill, Northumberland Co PA.
5. Lezette Daniel [Luzetta on tombstone], b. 7 Feb 1820 Northumberland Co PA; d. 28 May 1900 Brookville, Ogle Co IL; m. Henry Jacob Garman, b. 4 Aug 1819, d. 1 Mar 1893; both buried in Brookville Lutheran Cemetery in Carroll Co IL. They received 1/6th share of Henry Daniel Jr.'s right to his father Henry Daniel's Northumberland Co PA estate on 29 Mar 1843 [Northumberland Co Deeds, v. EE, p. 482].
6. Judit (Judith/Judy) Daniel, b. ca. 1821 Northumberland Co PA; d. after 1880 census Lower Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA; married Jacob Rotharmel, b. 2 Sep 1821 Lower Mahanoy Twp., Northumberland Co PA; d. 10 Mar 1898 PA; bur. Hickory Corners, Northumberland Co PA.

DOCUMENTS

Henry Daniel's Will – Northumberland Co PA Wills, v. 3, p. 390-391:

“In the name of God Amen, I Henry Daniel of the township of Jackson in the County of Northumberland and State of Pennsylvania, Yeoman, being weak in body and of sound mind, memory and understanding, but considering the uncertainty of this transitory life, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, to wit – First, It is my will, and I order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease, - Item, It is my will that after my decease, I order my Executors to make vendue of my moveable property and sell the same as quick as convenient after my decease, and collect all my outstanding Bonds & Notes and the money arising thereupon shall be divided among my Eight Heirs share and share alike, that is to say, to my daughter Christena, the wife of Adam Lefler, her share to her Heirs, my son John Daniel, my daughter Margaret the wife of John Bowman, to my son John George Daniel, to my son John Henry Daniel to his heirs, Magdalana the wife of Isaac Stewart, to my son John Adam Daniel, and to my son Andrew Daniel, further, I have sold my plantation which I live on to my son John Adam Daniel for the sum of Eight Hundred dollars and made him a Deed for the same which I have enclosed in my chest and is to have immediately after my decease, it is my will that my son John Adam Daniel shall have one hundred dollars in a draw out of my plantation, further it is my will that my son John Adam Daniel shall pay the full payment one year after my decease that is to say to the Heirs of my daughter Christena the sum of one Hundred dollars two years after my decease, one Hundred dollars to my son John Daniel three years after my decease, one Hundred dollars to my daughter Margaret the wife of John Bowman four years after my decease, one Hundred dollars to my son John George Daniel five years after decease, one Hundred dollars to the heirs of my son John Henry Daniel six years after my decease, on Hundred dollars to my daughter Magdalana the wife of Isaac Stewart seven years after my decease, one Hundred dollars to my son Andrew Daniel, - And Lastly, I nominate, constitute and appoint my said son John Adam Daniel and John Bowman to be my Executors of this my will hereby revoking all the wills, legacies and bequests, by me heretofore made, and declaring this and no other, to be my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Twenty-first day of June one thousand eight hundred & thirty eight.

Signed, sealed & declared by the said testator his last will and testament in the presence of us, Daniel Hilbush, Henry Latsha. Northumberland County SS.

Daniel Hilbush and Henry Latsha on their solemn oath say that they were personally present and did see Henry Daniel of Jackson township in said County, dec'd., sign, seal, publish & pronounce the above instrument of writing as and for his last will and testament, that at the time of so doing, he was of sound and disposing mind as for deponents firmly believe, and that deponents signed the same as witnesses in the presence & at the request of the said Testator and that the names Dnaiel Hilbush and Henry Latsha above written as witnesses is respectively the proper handwriting of the said Daniel Hilbush and Henry Latsha & further say not. Daneil Hilbush, Henry Latsha

Sworn & subscribed before me Edward Oyster, Depty Reg., for John G. Youngman, Register.

Be it remembered that on the 209th day of November, AD 1841 was proved and approved the last will and testament of Henry Daniel, late of Jackson township, decd., of which the foregoing is a true copy and that Letters Testamentary with the will annexed were granted to John Adam Daniel and John Bowman Executors in the said will named. Witness my hand, Jno. G. Youngman, Reg. for Edward Oyster, Depy. Reg." [Note: Several misspelled words have been corrected for readability in these transcriptions.]

Deed, Henry Daniel to John Adam Daniel – Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. CC, p. 113-115:

"Indenture, 21 Jun 1838, Henry Daniel of Jackson Twp., Northumberland Co PA to John Adam Daniel of same, in consideration of \$800, land in Jackson Twp., bounded by Henry Latshaw, Godlieb Leffler, Nicholas Seitzinger, containing 107 acres which was warranted to Godlieb Leffler on 22 Dec 1774, which became vested to Henry Daniel, who was granted a patent on 1 Dec 1806 (Patent Book No. 59, p. 148), signed Henry his X mark Daniel, witnessed by Daniel Hilbush and Henry Latsha, acknowledged 21 Jun 1838, recorded 20 Nov 1841.

Receipt, Heirs of Christena Leffler – Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. EE, p. 482:

"Received February the 21st, 1845, of John Adam Daniel, Executor of his Father's Estate, the sum of one Hundred and seventeen dollars the amount of money coming to the Heirs of Christena Leffler, deceased, wife of Adam Leffler, Jr., deceased, Mary M. Swingle, Nicholas Swingle, Elizabeth Dozer, George Dozer, Samuel Leffler, Peter Leffler, William Stainbrook, Margaret Stainbrook, Adam Leffler, Henry Leffler, Catharine Elson, Henry Stainbrook, Sarah Stainbrook, William Leffler. Recorded Decr. 17, 1845."

Deed of Release for John Bowman – Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. FF, p. 369-370:

"Know all men by these present that we John Bowman and Margret his wife one of the Daughters named in the last will and testament of Henry Daniel late of Upper Mahanoy township, Northumberland County, deceased, do hereby acknowledge that we have this day had and received of and from Adam Daniel, Executor of the testament and last will of the aforesaid Henry Daniel deceased, the sum of one hundred Dollars in full satisfaction and payment of all such sum or sums of money, legacies and bequests as are given and bequeathed to the said Margrett by the last will and testament aforesaid, and all interest accruing thereon. And therefore the said John Bowman and Margret his wife, do by these present release, acquit and forever discharge the said Adam Daniel his heirs Executors and administrators, of and from the said Legacy or legacies and of and from all actions suits payments accounts claims and demands whatsoever for or on account of one full share of the real estate of the said Henry Daniel decd. In witne3ss whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the 29th day of October 1847. John Bowman, Margret her X mark Bowman. Witness present, Peter Bixler, Benjamin Jacob. Northd. County SS. Be it Known that on

the 29th day of October 1847 before the subscriber, one of the Justices of the peace in and for the said county, came the above named John Bowman and Margret his wife and acknowledged the above release to be their act and deed and claimed that the same might be recorded as such according to Law. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written. Peter Bixler, J.N. Recorded Nov. 1, 1847.”

Deed of Release for Andrew Daniel – Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. GG, p. 368-369:

Be it remembered, That on the tenth day of February, A.D. 1823, letters of administration, in due and common form of law, were granted to Isaac Stewart of all and singular, the goods and chattels, rights and credits, which were of Henry Daniel, late of Upper Mahanoy township, Deceased, who have put in surety, Adam Daniel, in the sum of five hundred dollars. Deed of Release for Henry Garman – Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. EE, p. 482:

“We Henry Garman and Lezette, his wife, heirs & Legatees of Henry Daniel Late of Jackson township, Northumberland County deceased, do acknowledge to have received of Adam Daniel, one of executors of Henry Daniel Late deceased, the sixth Equal Share of the heirs of Henry Daniel Junr. deceased of the same township and county aforesaid each the sum of sixteen dollars sixty six cents the amount of Shares in full of the Real and personal estate of the said Henry Daniel Junr. deceased, and we hereby severally release and discharge the said Adam Daniel of and from all further Claims or demands on account of the same and we do also severally as well as Jointly hereby covenant and agree that we will upon demand repay to the said Adam Daniel so much of the same by us from him received, as may be wanting to pay and discharge any legal claims against the said Estate and of which at present the said Executor may not have any knowledge, witness our hand and seals this 29 March A.D. 1843. Henry Garman, Lezette her X mark Garman. Witness present, Daneil Hilbush, Jacob S. Garman.

Snyder, and Elisabeth Daniel, the Legacies in the said will [manjonit] and of his said Will made and constituted Adam Daniel and John Bauman sole executors as in and by the said will more fully and at large will appear. Know ye that we the said Elidia Daniel, now the wife of George Brown & Judit Daniel now the wife of Jacob Rotharmel & Susana Daniel now the wife of Abm. Snyder and Elisabeth Daniel do hereby confess and acknowledge that we have had and Received of and from Adam Daniel one of the above [manjonit], executors, Legacies in full to give and Bequeathed unto us by the said Henry Daniel and therefore do by these present to account, release and discharge the said Adam Daniel & John Bauman of and from all legacies due Duties & demands whatsoever which we our Executors or administrators may have claim or demand of or against the said Adam Daniel & John Bauman their Executors & administrators by virtue of the said Last Will and testament, of or out of the estate of the said Henry Daniel deceased as aforesaid in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hand and seal this thirty day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six. November the 30, 1846. George Brown, Elidia her X mark Brown, Jacob his X mark Rotharmel, Judit her X mark Rotharmel, Abraham Snyder, Susana her X mark Snyder, Elisabeth her X mark Daniel. Snyder & Susana Snyder, & Elisabeth Daneil, and acknowledged the above release to be their act and deed and desired the same to be recorded as such according to Law. Deed of Release for John Fetterman – Northumberland Co PA Deeds, v. FF, p. 337-338:

“Know all men by these present that in consideration of the sum of Nineteen dollars received to my full satisfaction of Adam Daniel, I hereby devise, Release & forever Quit Claim unto said Adam Daniel all my right, interest, and claim from the beginning of the world to the present day in the estate of Henry Daniel deceased, either real or personal. In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 5th day of April A.D. 1847. John Fetterman, Catharine her X mark Fetterman. Executed in presence of S. Overmyer, Michael Reed.

The State of Ohio, Sandusky County SS. Personally appeared before me, S. Overmyer, Justice of the peace in & for said county, John Fetterman, the signer of the above Release and acknowledged the signing and sealing thereof tho be his voluntary act and deed and also came Catharine Fetterman wife of said John and was by me examined separate and apart from her said husband and the contents to her made known, she then declared that she did voluntarily sign, seal and acknowledge the same and that she is still satisfied therewith, in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 5th day of April A.D. 1847.
